Scripture Reading Isaiah 6: 1-8

While at worship in the Temple in Jerusalem, Isaiah encounters God. Isaiah never actually glimpses God only seeing the hem or train of God's robe, which fills the Temple. So awesome is this encounter that Isaiah is overwhelmed with his own feelings of unworthiness as well as that of all humanity, our human limitations which separate us from God. However, Isaiah is purified by fire, which enables him to remain in God's presence and to respond to God's call.

Listen for the word of God.

In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lofty; and the hem of his robe filled the temple. Seraphs were in attendance above him; each had six wings: with two they covered their

faces, and with two they covered their feet, and with two they flew. And one called to another and said:

"Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts;
the whole earth is full of his glory."

The pivots on the thresholds shook at the voices of those who called, and the house filled with smoke. And I said: "Woe is me! I am lost, for I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips; yet my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts!"

Then one of the seraphs flew to me, holding a live coal that had been taken from the altar with a pair of tongs. The seraph touched my mouth with it and said: "Now that this has touched your lips, your guilt has departed and your sin is blotted out." Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?" And I said, "Here am I; send me!"

This is the witness of Israel.
