King City United Church COVID-19 SUNDAY WORSHIP PROCEDURE

Thank-you for your patience and we are glad to welcome you back to in-person worship We recognize the need for continued caution during the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and as a result have instituted the following procedures for future in-person worship events.

The policies described below may change as Provincial Guidelines change and are updated.

All Sunday services at the three churches will now begin at 10:00 am. There will be no coffee or socializing within the church building after worship. Any gathering outside after the worship must adhere to the 6 ft distancing guidelines. There are gathering limits in place and we require a RSVP in order to manage the numbers. You can RSVP to your church office.

You are asked to review and confirm your compliance with the following COVID-19 Precautions and Procedures prior to any attendance of service:

- You attest that you have been fully vaccinated by a Health Canada approved vaccine
- Neither you, nor anyone else attending service with you, has returned from travel outside Canada within the past 14 days, or has been in contact with an individual has returned from travel outside of Canada in the past 14 days **and** been asked to isolate.
- Neither you, nor anyone else attending service with you, have shown any symptoms of COVID-19 in the past 14 days. (Symptoms include but are not limited to; fever, cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, loss of taste/smell, runny nose, pink eye)
- Neither you, nor anyone else attending service with you have knowingly been close to nor come in contact with anyone that has a presumptive or a confirmed diagnosis of Covid-19 in the last 14 days
- Neither you nor any close contacts have been asked to isolate in the last 14 days.
- You will be required to sign in on arrival with your name and contact number when entering the building
- Please sanitize your hands upon entering and exiting the church building
- Please ensure that you and your family, partner, friend, will limit touching as much
 possible within the church building during the service. Please leave everything in the
 building as it was found, ie. lights, doors, etc. Do not touch or use any hymn books or
 bible books
- Those sharing a household space will be permitted to sit together however, if you are from different households you must distance 6 feet even if you arrived in the same vehicle to the church. Seating will be designated and you will be guided to an area.
- Washrooms are open and we ask that you follow the posted hand washing instructions.
- Masks which cover your nose and mouth are required and must be worn throughout the entire worship service.
- Please do not enter the any office in the building (admin, minister, nursery school) during your time at service.
- Please do not enter the kitchen during your time at service.
- There will be no singing of hymns during the worship service
- Should you take a bulletin during service, please bring it home with you.
